I submit as follows

A The regulations ought to , in addition to current provisions , require that no tree branches may be of such height and width such that if the tree were to fall that such tree would make contact with power lines

B That no tree should be allowed to grow under power lines if that tree would be likely to grow to such a height that it would interfere with power lines. Removing such trees would have a long term saving on maintenance costs.

C That if any landholder planted a tree that would impact on power lines as per B above, the landowner would be responsible for the cost of removal of that tree

D That if any power utility installed new lines above trees would impact on power lines as per B above, the power utility would be responsible for the cost of removal of that tree and replacement with suitable trees.
